Upon graduation from law school in 2013, Ms. Marron started her legal career in the Monmouth Trial Region of the New Jersey Office of the Public Defender. As a staff attorney, she represented clients in a variety of trials and motion practice including charges of drug possession and distribution, aggravated assault, stalking, and homicides. She was named the OPD's Attorney of the Month in November 2018 for back-to-back trial wins.
