- Recent Educational Trends Women (U.S.)
- > 59% of biology degrees (increasing)
- 50% of chemistry degrees (increasing)
- 18.4% of engineering degrees (static)
 - Chemical engineering 32.1%
 - Electrical engineering 10.7%
 - Mechanical engineering 11.8%
- > 18.2% of computer science degrees (decreasing)


