Alexander Kramer is an Assistant Chief in the Foreign Corrupt Practices Act ("FCPA") Unit of the U.S. Department of Justice, Criminal Division, Fraud Section. Alex has investigated and prosecuted a number of individuals and companies in FCPA and other white collar cases, including the successful prosecution and trial conviction of Carlos Polit in the U.S. District for the Southern District of Florida in connection with a scheme whereby Carlos Polit, the former Comptroller General of Ecuador, solicited and received over \$10 million in bribe payments from Odebrecht S.A. and others and laundered those bribe payments in South Florida.

Before joining the FCPA Unit, Alex worked as a Trial Attorney in the Fraud Section's Health Care Fraud Unit, where he prosecuted Medicare fraud and opioid cases. He also worked on commodities fraud cases with the Fraud Section's Market Integrity and Major Frauds Unit. Prior to joining the Fraud Section in 2016, Alex spent seven years at Foley & Lardner LLP in Washington, D.C. Alex graduated from the University of California, Irvine and the University of California, Davis School of Law.
