

David L. Rebuck, Former Director, New Jersey Division of Gaming Enforcement



David L. Rebuck was named by Governor Chris Christie in April 2011 to be Director of the New Jersey Division of Gaming Enforcement.

Rebuck had served for 23 years as a Deputy Attorney General for New Jersey, specializing in policy guidance and regulatory reform. He was assigned to the Governor's Office as a Senior Policy Advisor to Governor Christie in February 2010.

During his tenure he oversaw numerous endeavors to modernize the regulation of gaming in New Jersey, including instituting regulatory reform initiatives, creating online casino gaming functionality and sports wagering options.

Recognized by the International Masters of Gaming Law as their 2013 Regulator of the Year, Rebuck also is a trustee member of the International Association of Gaming Regulators.

He is a member of the New Jersey Bar.
