Greta Anschuetz serves as the Assistant Commissioner for the Division of HIV, STD and TB Services. Greta started her public health career interning at Children's Hospital of Philadelphia on the Connect to Protect® adolescent HIV prevention program and at the Philadelphia Department of Public Health (PDPH) working on the high school STD screening program. Greta ultimately spent almost 12 years at PDPH as, first, the STD epidemiologist, then managing the surveillance team, ensuring that all cases of chlamydia, gonorrhea, and syphilis had complete reporting. Greta started at the New Jersey Department of Health in 2018 as the STD Director. In 2018-2019, Greta was elected by her fellow STD Directors across the country as Chair of the Board of the National Coalition of STD Directors. Currently, Greta serves as the STD subcommittee chair for the Council of State and Territorial Epidemiologists. She was promoted to Assistant Commissioner in January 2023 and continues to work to improve sexual health and monitor the tuberculosis risk of all New Jerseyans.
