Jamie McKelvey is the Assistant Bureau Chief for the Technical Services Bureau and Revenue Certification – Legal and serves as the Responsible Gaming Coordinator at the New Jersey Division of Gaming Enforcement. In her role as Assistant Bureau Chief, Jamie oversees the Revenue Certification Unit and Technical Services Bureau, manages background investigations, and addresses internet gaming, retail, and mobile sports wagering matters. She also handles all aspects of litigation within her assigned bureaus, including screening cases, discovery, petitions, trials, and appellate briefings.

As the Division's Responsible Gaming Coordinator, Jamie leads the development, oversight, and implementation of New Jersey's responsible gaming programs and initiatives, ensuring they align with best practices and effectively address problem gambling. Before joining the Division, Jamie served as a Deputy Attorney General with the Division of Criminal Justice – Prosecutor Supervision and Training Bureau, creating and delivering training programs for law enforcement and prosecutors. She also worked as an Assistant Prosecutor with the Atlantic County Prosecutor's Office, where she prosecuted cases involving sexual assault, domestic violence, and weapons offenses. Jamie earned her J.D. from Rutgers School of Law – Camden and holds an undergraduate degree from Rutgers University – New Brunswick.
