John T. Crisan was responsible for privacy and acted as Chief Privacy Officer at Johnson & Johnson (J&J) for 8 years through 2020, with responsibility for leading the global organization that manages the data privacy and compliance requirements for the enterprise. The world's largest and most diversified healthcare company (over \$80 billion in revenue), J&J is a leader in pharmaceuticals and biologics, medical devices and diagnostics, and consumer healthcare products.

Prior to his Chief Privacy Officer role, he served as Chief Compliance Officer for J&J, with responsibility for a 500-person global health care compliance, government contracting & privacy organization, as well as leading the corporate Compliance Committee (comprised of leaders of the different risk functions for the enterprise), with oversight of Enterprise Risk Management for J&J. The role reported into the Executive Committee of the company as well as to the Board of Directors. His immediately prior role was General Counsel for the Consumer healthcare products division of J&J (\$14 billion in revenue), and has served as a Board member on multiple joint-ventures of Johnson & Johnson in China, India, Japan and the U.S. Earlier roles included lead attorney for group supporting L&A activity in the Pharmaceutical and Consumer business sectors at Johnson & Johnson (over \$30 billion in revenue), including significant experience in negotiating, structuring and integrating businesses along with other related L&A activity (including equity investments).

In a private capacity, Mr. Crisan recently completed a 5 year term as Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Children's Specialized Hospital Foundation (a \$100 million NJ-based charitable foundation) and as a member of the Board of Trustees of Children's Specialized Hospital (the largest pediatric rehabilitative hospital in the U.S.), while also having previously spent 8 years on the Foundation Board in various capacities. He currently serves as a member of the Board of Trustees of International Schools Services in Princeton, NJ (the non-profit leader in global education) and as a member of the Board of Visitors of Seton Hall University Law School in Newark, NJ.

Mr. Crisan joined J&J 30 years ago from the New York City law firm of O'Sullivan Graev & Karabell (since merged into O'Melveny & Myers), where he specialized in corporate law, with an emphasis on venture capital and small-to-midmarket M&A. Prior to his work with O'Sullivan
