Joseph Zimmerman has nearly 30 years of experience in the pharmaceutical industry in leadership roles of increasing responsibility in such areas as corporate compliance, privacy, government affairs, leadership development, training, management, and sales. Joe currently serves as Vice President, Chief Compliance Officer and Head of Privacy for Incyte Corporation, positions which he has held since January 2026.

Prior to Incyte, Joe served four years as Senior Vice President, Chief Compliance Officer at SpringWorks Therapeutics, Inc. responsible for Compliance, Quality Assurance, and Privacy and was a member of the Executive Leadership Team reporting to the CEO. Joe joined SpringWorks at an early pre-commercial stage and helped active two US and European approvals and launches culminating in the company being acquired Merck KGaA.

Prior to SpringWorks he served over five years as Vice President, Chief Compliance & Privacy Officer, and Head of U.S. Government Affairs at Ferring Pharmaceuticals, Inc. and operated a health care compliance and business operations consulting company. Until late 2015, he served as Senior Vice President and Chief Compliance Officer for two multi-billion dollar publicly traded companies: Actavis (merged with Allergan now Abbvie) and Forest Laboratories (acquired by Actavis). He held the position of Global Chief Compliance Officer for Forest starting in 2004, where he established the corporate function and managed the teams providing compliance support for numerous new product or indication approvals, branded drug launches, and through various M&A activity.

Mr. Zimmerman received a B.S. in Biology from Bradley University, and has received regular training and certifications in Compliance, Ethics, Fraud & Abuse, and Investigations. He is a regular participant in government and industry Chief Compliance Officer roundtables, periodically speaks to compliance professionals at industry conferences and since 2018 has served a term as an elected Co-Chair of the Pharmaceutical Compliance Forum (PCF) and from 2021 - 2024 in a term as Chair of the Forum.
