Magda Schaler-Haynes is Professor of Health Policy and Management and of Population and Family Health at the Mailman School of Public Health at Columbia University. Her scholarship and teaching focus on the use of law to advance equitable public health policy in diverse arenas including healthcare professional licensing, reproductive and maternal health, antidiscrimination initiatives and pandemic response. Prior to joining the full-time faculty, Schaler-Haynes spent over two decades working in health law and policy including multiple senior roles in public service at state and federal levels. She served in the administration of New Jersey Governor Phil Murphy, most recently as Senior Advisor at the New Jersey Office of the Attorney General; previously as Director of Policy and Strategic Planning at the New Jersey Department of Health. She has also held roles as Special Advisor for healthcare and women's issues to a U.S. Senator and as Senior Health Policy Advisor at the New York State Insurance Department. Schaler-Haynes holds J.D. and M.P.H. degrees from Columbia University and B.A. from Brandeis University.
