Dr. Matthew H. Hersch is a Fellow and Adjunct Professor of Law, Gibbons Institute of Law, Science & Technology at Seton Hall University School of Law, as well as a Golieb Fellow in Legal History at NYU. He received his JD from NYU and his PhD in the History and Sociology of Science from the University of Pennsylvania, during which he held a Guggenheim Fellowship at the Smithsonian Institution's National Air and Space Museum and a History of Science Society-NASA Fellowship in the History of Space Science. He has held faculty appointments at Penn, the University of Southern California, and Harvard, where he is a Faculty Associate. Dr. Hersch has held Fellowships with the American Council of Learned Societies and the Huntington-USC Institute on California and the West; Dr. Hersch is also a Member of the Institute for Advanced Study, in Princeton, New Jersey. He is the author of *Dark Star: A New History of the Space Shuttle* (MIT Press, 2023), *Inventing the American Astronaut* (Palgrave Macmillan, 2012), co-author of *A Social History of American Technology, 2nd Edition* (Oxford University Press, 2018), and co-editor of *War and Peace in Outer Space: Ethical and Legal Boundaries* (Oxford University Press, 2021).
