Thereafter, he practiced in top-tier American and Singapore law firms specializing in commercial litigation, data protection, and corporate investigations work for Fortune 500 companies in the life sciences, technology, and financial sectors across the Asia-Pacific region.

After more than a decade of government service and private practice, he took his first gig in-house at Meta Platforms (the parent company of Facebook, Instagram, WhatsApp) as an Associate General Counsel, where he led its Cybersecurity Law and Investigations team for the Asia-Pacific region for four years where he successfully represented the company before regulators on multiple significant matters.
