Rhea started her legal career in private practice at a small general practice law firm in Louisiana.

Due to her subject matter expertise in horse racing, she was approached to join the Louisiana Attorney General's office as an Assistant Attorney General and thereafter assigned to the Louisiana State Racing Commission to provide legal counsel. This included administratively

prosecuting cases, representing the Commission in Judicial Review actions in all court proceedings. She also provided counsel on public record laws, open meetings laws, administrative procedure act, and drafted regulations.

Rhea was the first in the United States to successfully prosecute the Dermorphin "Frog Juice" cases in 2012, where a number of licensed Louisiana Trainers were caught administering the prohibited substance to their racehorses.

Rhea joined Penn Interactive in 2019 first as the Director of Compliance and more recently promoted to the VP of Compliance & Regulatory Affairs. In this role, she is responsible for all compliance functions of Penn Interactive, covering the Barstool Sportsbook & iCasino in multiple states, HollywoodCasino.com iCasino in PA, Hollywood Races Advanced Deposit Wagering, Penn Games Studio, and social games.

In her personal life she is a distance runner, preferring marathons and up to 100-mile races.
