Ms. Patel has convicted several individuals in FCPA, money laundering, and tax offenses relating to corruption at *Petróleos de Venezuela S.A.*, and has worked on two corporate resolutions. Before joining the Fraud Section, Ms. Patel was an Assistant United States Attorney in the United States Attorney’s Office for the District of Columbia, clerked for the Honorable Emmet G. Sullivan of the United States District Court for the District of Columbia, and worked at Davis Polk & Wardwell LLP in New York. Ms. Patel graduated *cum laude* from Columbia University, was a Fulbright Scholar, and received her law degree at the University of Pennsylvania Law School.
