Title IX: What to do if Sexually Assaulted; Reporting and Resources

Immediate Steps

Get to a safe place and call for help

- Call 911 (Newark Police Department)
- Public Safety & Security 973-7642-8725
- Counseling and Psychological Services (CAPS) 973-761-9500
- Office of the Dean of Students 973-642-8707

Receive medical assistance

- Receive treatment for physical injuries
- Screen for sexually transmitted diseases/pregnancy
- If possible, <u>do not</u> shower, clean up, change clothes, or use the toilet—hospital staff can collect evidence using a rape kit
- If you want to file a report, you can call the police from the emergency room
